



THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH
BY-LAW #1004

A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH, IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES, TO ESTABLISH A SMOKING AND CANNABIS USE IN PUBLIC PLACES BYLAW, PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTIONs 70, 71, 72, 73, 73, AND 75 OF THE CITIES, TOWNS AND VILLAGE ACT S.N.W.T, 2003, c.22.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith, in the Northwest Territories, recognizes that it has been the custom to encourage the citizens of Fort Smith to enjoy and participate in the Wood Buffalo Frolics by proclaiming a half day civic holiday on the Friday of the Wood Buffalo Frolics weekend;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Fort Smith, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows;

1. THAT the period of 12:00 noon until 5:00 p.m. (Mountain Time) on the Friday of the Wood Buffalo Frolics weekend each year is hereby declared to be a civic holiday.
2. THAT this Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of its final passing.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 31st DAY OF March, 2020 A.D.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS 21st DAY OF April, 2020 A.D.
