

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH

BY-LAW 598

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH, IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES, TO AUTHORIZE THE LEASING OF LAND, PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 132 OF THE CITIES, TOWNS AND VILLAGES ACT BEING CHAPTER 14, 1987 (1ST) OF THE STATUTES OF THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES

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WHEREAS, the land lease covering the Town of Fort Smith's Landfill Site, expired in July, 1988.

AND WHEREAS, the Town wishes to continue using these lands for public nuisance grounds;


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith, at a duly assembled meeting hereby authorizes the Mayor and Senior Administrative Officer to enter into a lease renewal agreement with the Government of the Northwest Territories, for:

the whole of Lots numbered Two Hundred and Eleven (211) and Two Hundred and Twelve (212) in the Town of Fort Smith in the Northwest Territories, according to a plan of survey filed in the Land Titles Office for the Northwest Territories under number 19, excepting thereout and therefrom all that portion of a road right-of-way as shown on a plan of survey filed in said Land Title Office under number 258;

and excepting thereout and therefrom the whole of Lots Two Hundred and Eleven dash One (211-1) and Two Hundred and Twelve dash One (212-1) as shown on a plan of survey filed in the said Land Titles Office under number 344.

THAT By-Law 411 is repealed.
