SHOULD YOU BE ADVISED TO EVACUATE:

1. Load your family and your family's Emergency Kit in your vehicle.
2. Bring this form – ensure it is completed.
3. Drive to the closest road leading to Highway 5 to the Muster Station for further instructions. Personnel manning the Muster Station will collect this form, check for sufficient fuel, and provide an information form regarding the centre we are evacuating to (or contact information should you choose to travel elsewhere so you can receive up-to-date news).
4. The RCMP will provide information as to evacuation procedures and route. Most likely you will be travelling in a convoy to ensure safety as you drive out. It will be important to drive responsibly at a safe speed so there are no accidents.
5. A Daily Bulletin will be placed on the website to keep residents who have been evacuated on the status of the emergency.

Keep the completed form in a prominent location in your home and bring it with you if an evacuation is called, whether by air or road.

Should you be leaving town for holidays, please drop the completed form at Town Hall.

Additional forms are available at Town Hall for families who may evacuate separately
